

## ALLOW READING FRIENDLY TOOLS

#### **CHALLENGE**

Straightening oraganization skills.

#### **EXPLANATION**

Dyspraxic students have attention difficulties which affects their reading ability. As it's difficult for them to follow the text smoothly with eyes without moving head excessively, they have the tendency to lose the place while reading.

#### **ADAPTATION**

In order to simplify the reading exercises, allow students to use colorful ruler (younger) or let them use their fingers to follow the line (older).

### **Example**

Dyspraxic friendly ruler should have a bulge for students to put their fingers. Placing fingers in the middle of the ruler gives a sense of resistance so the ruler doesn't slip around while reading.

Younger students could benefit from using a ruler which allows them to have a grip like for example this model with a fun crocodile:

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As the students get older they can move towards more comprehensive setting. The important thing is some kind of ridge in the middle of ruler which makes it easy to grasp.


