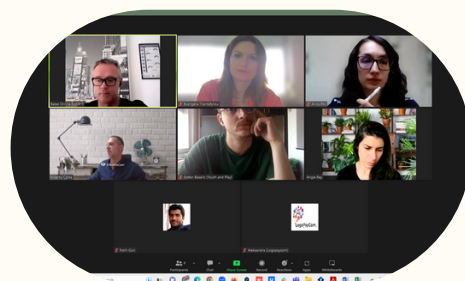
# 1st Transnational Project Meeting
